

What is Roku?

ROKU is a small device which you can connect to your television to view an assortment of movies in the comfort of your home.

Rockville Centre patrons may borrow a Roku for 14 days and watch any TV series or movie in the library's My Fandango account.

Rules

- ROKU sticks go out for 14 days and are non-renewable.
- There is a \$0.50 per day late fee. A \$60.00 replacement fee will be charged if all 6 components are not returned and are lost/damaged (includes Roku stick, remote, 2-piece power cord, HDMI Extender and instructions).
- Must be returned to circulation (**No Book or Media Drop**).
- Patrons cannot alter any settings (**other than Network**), or tamper with the Roku in any way.
- Patrons cannot purchase movies or add any content to the Roku. The Roku will be examined upon return. Charges will be added to the patron's account for any damage found.
- Patrons must be in good standing to check out a Roku stick.

Requirements

- An HDTV with HDMI port.
- High-speed wireless internet.



Instructions for Installing and Using the ROKU

Insert the ROKU Stick

- Plug the Roku stick into an available HDMI port on your TV
- Connect the power cord and adapter to a wall outlet.
- Use your TV remote to switch the input to the corresponding HDMI port.

Connect to WiFi

- Press **Home** on the ROKU remote, navigate to **Settings**, and press **OK**.
- Select **Network > Set Up Connection > Wireless** and press **OK**.
- Highlight **Wireless** and press **OK**.
- Choose your WiFi network, enter your password, and connect.

Open Fandango at Home (or Vudu)

- Press **Home**, navigate to **Fandango at Home** (may appear as **Vudu**) and press **OK**

Find and Watch Your Movie or TV Show

- In the app, navigate to **My Library** and press **OK**.
- Select your movie or TV show and enjoy!
